Application Notes Additional Information: This antibody reacts with the heavy chains on goat IgG and with the light chains on all goat immunoglobulins based on immunoelectrophoresis. Minimum cross-reactivity is observed to non-immunoglobulin goat serum proteins based on immunoelectrophoresis. Antibody is supplied in 10 mM sodium phosphate, 150 mM sodium chloride, pH 7, 0.05 % (w/v) sodium azide as preservative. BSA and milk have to be replaced by other blocking reagents, like donkey serum or commercial formulations which are free from bovine IgG. Background: Rabbit anti-goat IgG (H&L), affinity purified is a secondary antibody which binds to goat IgGs in immunological assays. Antibodies are affinity purified using solid phase goat IgG.
