### Pig (Swine) normal serum (2 ml) GRP12598

<b>Species/Host</b>	Pig
<b>Form/Appearance</b>	Lyophilized
<b>Storage</b>	Store lyophilized material at 2-8 °C. For long term storage after reconstitution, prepare small aliquots and store at -20 °C . For storage at 2-8 °C, add a preservative to prevent growth of bacteria. Rehydrate with 2.0 ml of deionized water. Swirl gently and let stand for up to 2 hours at 18-25 °C. Centrifuge reconstituted serum to remove any precipitates.
<b>Note</b>	For research use only.
<b>Purity</b>	Serum
<b>Application Notes</b>	Additional Information: Protein concentration is 60.0 mg/ml (Bradford, IgG standards). Antibody is supplied in 10 mM sodium phosphate, 0.15 M sodium chloride, pH 7.2. No preservative is added. Background: Normal pig (swine) serum lipid extracted and dialyzed against 10 mM sodium phosphate, 0.15 M sodium chloride, pH 7.2. This product is used as a blocking reagent or control for most immunoassay applications. Reconstitution: For reconstitution add 2.2 ml of sterile water.
